Resume Tips:

1. Always one page.
2. First column is the name of the project, second column is the character name and category, third column is the director's name and production company.
3. Categories:
 - BP: Background Performer or extra
 - SOC: silent on camera, commercial term only
 - VO: voice over, as in radio commercials
 - Actor: 1-5 lines
 - Principal: 6+ lines
4. Do not include character assessments, as in, "Jimmy is an articulate boy who gets along with others". Stick to the acting facts only. Directors do not want to wade through extraneous material.
5. For an inexperienced actor, use huge font, add clip art, a border, etc.
6. Do not include personal contact information. This is a safety and privacy issue.
7. Update resumes at least every six months or more frequently if your child is working.
8. Stick to the facts, they don't want Mom's character assessments "Jane is a funny girl who gets along with others"
